Safety

Passengers-in-wheelchairs (PIW) should board only wheelchair accessible bus (WAB) services, which can be easily identified by the wheelchair logo pasted on the lower left hand corner of the bus windscreen.



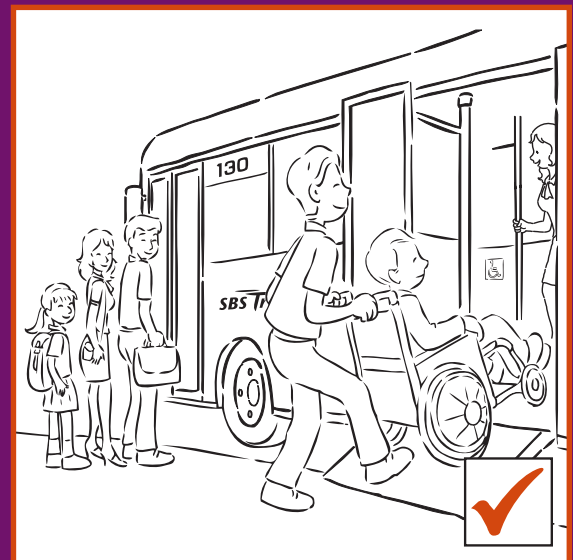
Bus services that are not wheelchair-friendly could have several bus stops along their routes that are not barrier-free. This could be in the form of steps, narrow passageway or even too low a kerb; all of which could pose a safety hazard to PIWs during boarding or alighting.

As such, we welcome PIWs to board only our WAB services as we value the safety of our passengers when they travel with us.

Priority Boarding

Our Bus Captains will attend to the boarding / alighting needs of a PIW first, whenever possible, before opening the front door for regular boarding activities.

To assist our Bus Captains, we seek the co-operation of PIWs to flag the bus early and, if possible, wait in an area at the bus stop where you can be easily spotted by our approaching bus.



Safe Travel Tips

The designated wheelchair space is meant for a PIW and passengers should not leave their belongings there unattended.

For PIWs, please park your wheelchair against the backrest and lock the wheels.
