

Fact Sheet 3 – Facts on Ang Mo Kio Bus Interchange

The new Ang Mo Kio Interchange is located at the same site as the original interchange which started operation since April 1983. In March 2002, it shifted to a temporary location at the junction of Ang Mo Kio Avenue 8 and Central 2 to facilitate the construction of the Ang Mo Kio Hub.

- Ang Mo Kio Bus Interchange is operated by SBS Transit
- It began operations about 3 months ago, on 28 April 2007
- It is the 3rd and the latest interchange managed by SBS Transit to be air-conditioned
- It is part of Ang Mo Kio Hub and provides seamless integration with retail outlets and MRT station
- Serves 15 services: 14 by SBS Transit and 1 by SMRT
- Doors at boarding berths equipped with detectors; doors will only open when a bus calls at the bus bay
- 9 berths available – 6 for boarding; 3 for alighting
- 36 bus parking lots
