Memorandum of Understanding between SBS Transit and Community Chest

Aim:

The MOU formalises the partnership between SBS Transit and Community Chest to promote philanthropic giving in the public transport sector and support a collaborative and impactful social service ecosystem through curated Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) initiatives under SBS Transit's newly-launched C2E2 (Corporate Philanthropy, Community Engagement, Employee Volunteerism and Environment Stewardship) CSR framework.

Areas of focus:

 SBS Transit intends to donate the total sum of \$750,000 over three years as part of corporate philanthropy towards Community Chest's supported programmes related to Persons with Disabilities (PwDs) and those with mental health conditions.

Benefits:

- 100% of the donations will go towards empowering the cause supported by SBS Transit.
- Community Chest will partner SBS Transit to identify suitable yearly ComChest's signature events for support, including the participation of volunteering activities by staff of SBS Transit.

Duration:

The duration for the cooperation shall be for a period of three years between FY2024 to FY2026, starting from 1 April 2024.
