

## **FAQs for NS50 Free Travel Day**

### **Q. What is the NS50 Free Travel Day about?**

The NS50 Free Travel Day is organised by the public transport operators as a mark of recognition for the contributions of all national servicemen. The NS50 Free Travel is part of the year-long NS50 celebrations.

The NS50 Free Travel Day applies to all public bus, train and LRT services operated by SBS Transit, SMRT Corporation, Tower Transit Singapore and Go-Ahead Singapore. Private-hire buses and taxis are not covered.

### **Q. When is the NS50 Free Travel Day?**

The NS50 Free Travel Day applies from the first to the last bus, MRT and LRT service for 30 June. Please check with the relevant public transport operator for first and last service timings on 30 June.

### **Q. Who is eligible for the NS50 Free Travel Day?**

Full-time National Servicemen (NSF), Operationally Ready National Servicemen (NSmen), servicemen in MINDEF Reserve and ex-NSmen who wear their service uniform are eligible for free travel on 30 June 2017.

### **Q. How will the NS50 Free Travel Day be carried out?**

If you are a NSF, NSman, in MR or an ex-NSmen, you have to wear your service uniform on 30 June when you take public bus, MRT and LRT services. Refer to below for the procedure when you board a bus or enter a MRT/LRT station:

- For bus service, the bus captain will identify your status as a national serviceman based on your uniform and allow you on board.
- For MRT service, please approach the station staff at the control station for assistance. You will be let through the fare gantries thereafter.
- For LRT service, please alert the station staff through the intercom beside the fare gantries. You will be let through the fare gantries thereafter.

When exiting MRT and LRT stations:

- For MRT service, please approach the station staff at the control station for assistance. You will be let through the fare gantries once verified.
- For LRT service, please alert the station staff through the intercom beside the fare gantries. You will be let through the fare gantries thereafter.

**Q. Which uniforms are permitted?**

SAF national servicemen should wear their No. 3 or No. 4 uniform, while SPF and SCDF national servicemen should wear their service uniform. Past-generation uniforms, such as the SAF Temasek Green No. 4, are also permitted.
