EXECUTIVE BUS ROLES

INTERCHANGE MANAGER

- ▶ You will manage one of our bus interchange groups with a total staff strength of about 400 staff and Bus Captains to provide bus service.
- ▶ You will implement policies and achieve key performance indicators including reliability, customer service, safety, security and maintenance of the interchanges.

- Degree in any discipline with a minimum of 10 years of working experience, of which at least 4 years are in operations and managing a large workforce.
- Results-oriented and able to respond to daily operational contingencies effectively in a fast-paced environment.
- Enjoy managing people and able to interact well with staff of all levels.
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills.
- Able to work independently with minimal supervision.

EXECUTIVE SERVICE CONTROLLER

- ▶ You will ensure optimal deployment of resources using the Common Fleet Management System (CFMS).
- ▶ You will lead and manage a team of Assistant Service Controllers, using online resources and support systems to conduct real-time monitoring of bus service performance.
- ▶ You will take necessary actions to minimise service delays, resolve emergencies and restore service disruptions to ensure service reliability on the roads.
- ▶ You will also need to make critical decisions and ensure appropriate communication with all parties involved. In addition, you will analyse trends and recommend improvements for overall service performance and resource applications.
- ▶ Extensive training in operational policies, procedures and service controls will be provided.

- Degree in any discipline with a minimum of 2 years of working experience in Operations preferred.
- Calm and controlled when responding to stressful or unpredictable situations.
- Strong situational awareness ability and leadership qualities.
- Excellent analytical, problem-solving and organisational skills.
- Able to perform shift work.
- Will undergo a series of aptitude tests upon successful selection.

EXECUTIVE RAIL ROLES

SENIOR/ENGINEER

Communications, Facilities Management, Permanent Way, Power, Rolling Stock, Signaling

- ▶ You will identify technical problems or performance gaps in the area of specialisation, carry out technical investigations and analyse faults whilst recommending solutions and ensuring compliance and adherence to operating standards, safety rules and regulations.
- ▶ You will also provide guidance and technical advice to Senior/Technical Officers and Senior/Technicians, as well as assess their performance and training needs.

- Degree in an Engineering discipline related to the area of specialisation.
- Team player with good interpersonal skills and able to work independently.
- Good written and verbal skills along with supervisory and leadership qualities.

TRAFFIC CONTROLLER

- ▶ You will monitor and control train operational activities to ensure that safe, efficient and reliable train services are provided at all times.
- ▶ You will also coordinate and mobilise relevant Engineering and Operations staff to resolve failures or unexpected events in the most expeditious and safe manner.

- Degree in any discipline, or Diploma holder with 3 years of working experience.
- Able to remain calm and make logical decisions in a stressful environment.

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
